Learning Disability: A learning disability is a reduced intellectual ability and difficulty with everyday activities – for example household tasks, socialising or managing money – which affects someone for their whole life.

Community Connector: The name of a job for someone with a learning disability to work with Sarah on this project.

Our Active Community: This is the name of our project to help people who have a learning disability to get active in Worthing.

Community: The people and places in an area.

Employed: To give paid work to someone to do a job.

Worthing Mencap: The local organisation you will be employed by for this job.

Community Partner: The name of Sarah's job.

Physical Activity: Doing things that get your body moving. For example, walking, dancing, and swimming.

Conversations: A chat between 2 or more people.
